The needs of an ageing and diverse population, the changing burden of disease and rising patient and public expectations mean that innovative ways of providing effective and efficient high-quality rehabilitation outcomes must be found. People must be empowered to take control of their own lives, manage their conditions and draw on community assets as well as NHS services to make this happen.

Delays in starting rehabilitation can increase the risk of further deterioration in the patient's condition, resulting in reduced independence. Starting rehabilitation early following a stroke or post-surgery can improve physical, psychological wellbeing and emotional recovery, preventing future problems.
