Operating Instructions for Electronic Wheelchair Scale




Caution! Load Cell damage can occur if scale is allowed to fall from storage position.

① From transport position, lay scale on floor.

DO NOT remove the Storage Pin or operate Column Release Lever prior to this operation.

DO NOT USE SCALE ON CARPETED FLOORS!

② Remove the Storage Pin.



③ Slide the Column Release Lever to release column and lift to full up-right and locked position.








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- ④ Press the ON key located on front of the indicator.
- (5) When the indicator reads Zero, press the **TARE** key, enter the wheelchair weight, then press the **ENTER** key. The indicator will show a negative weight equal to the weight of wheelchair.



(9) For storage, use column release to release column and fold down to locked position. Replace storage pin (see warning label on scale base). Store in an up-right position, preferably near a wall for maximum protection against damage. HINT: If indicator is on when storing, press the ZERO key to zero the indicator which activates the automatic shutoff.

- ⁶ Position patient on scale by pulling wheelchair onto scale. NEVER PUSH patient on or off scale. Lock wheelchair wheels.
- When weight reading is steady, read the patient's weight.
- 8 Remove patient from scale by backing down the ramp.



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
